

Building a Simple Ash Sifter

Material List:

- 2x4's or 2x2's
- Wire Mesh (different sizes)
- Deck screws (3 ½ inch)

Tools:

- Hammer
 - Power Drill
 - Wire Cutter
 - Tape Measure
 - Power Saw
 - Staple gun/staples
 - Pencil/marker
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Sifter Stand

Material List:

- 2x2's / 2x4's and 1x3's
- Deck Screws or nails

Tool List:

- Saw
 - Drill (bits for starter holes)
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- Can build any height to make the sifting easier on your back.
 - This can be moved from site to site
 - Be sure your sifter is larger than the stand top opening.
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24" x 24" Sifter

Material List:

- 1 – 2x4x8'
- Wire Mesh
- Wire Cutter
- Common Nails
- Hammer
- Nail Staples



Bottom of Sifter Stand

- ☐ Brace the legs of the stand
- ☐ leave space to set a 5-gal bucket underneath to catch ash.



Sifter Stand

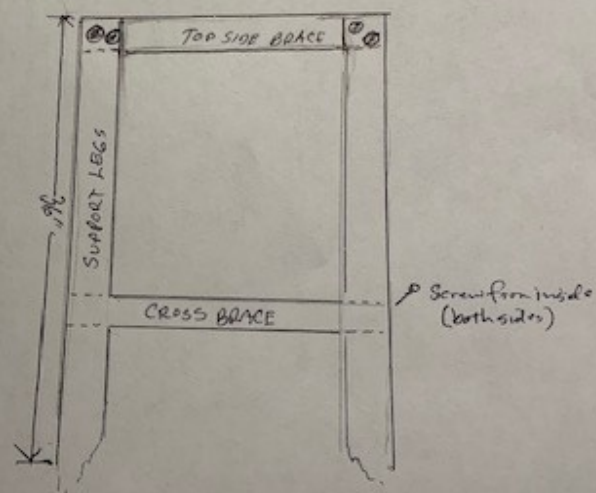
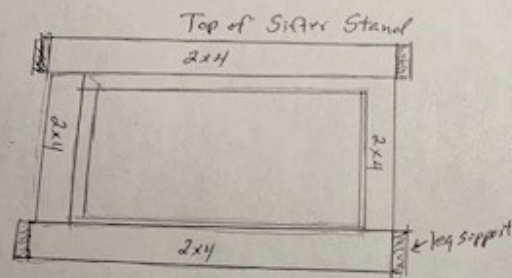
This stand can be made

•Sifter with Handles

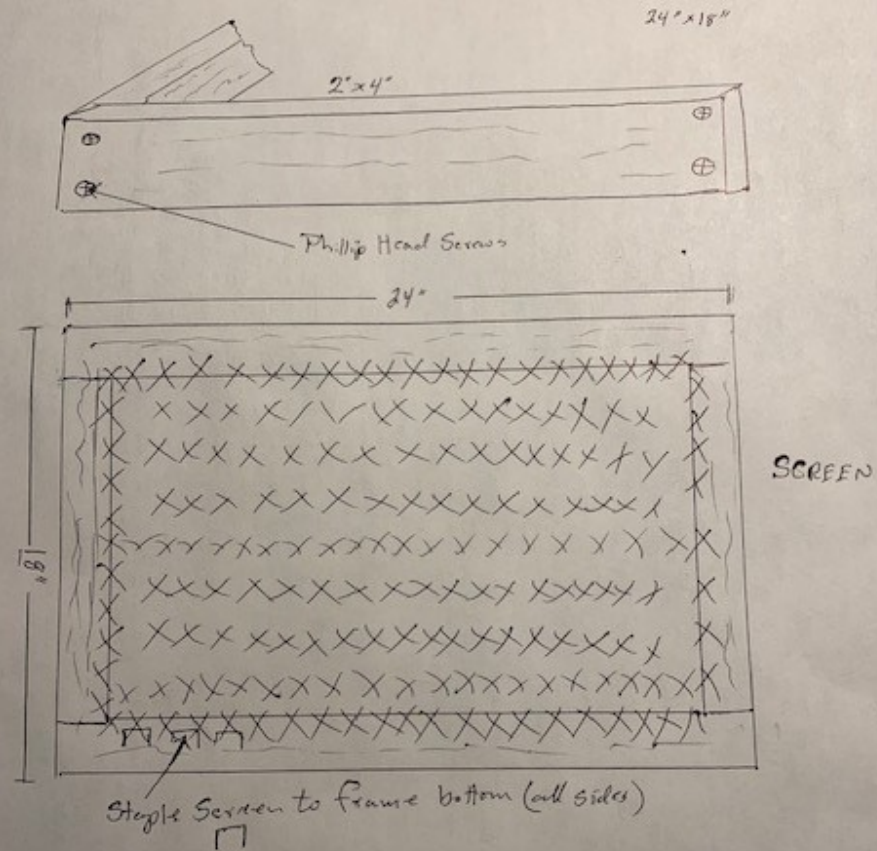
- 3- 2x4's
- Mesh screen
- Phillip head screws (3 ½ inch)
- Staples
- Staple gun
- Hammer



Use 2x2's for legs + support

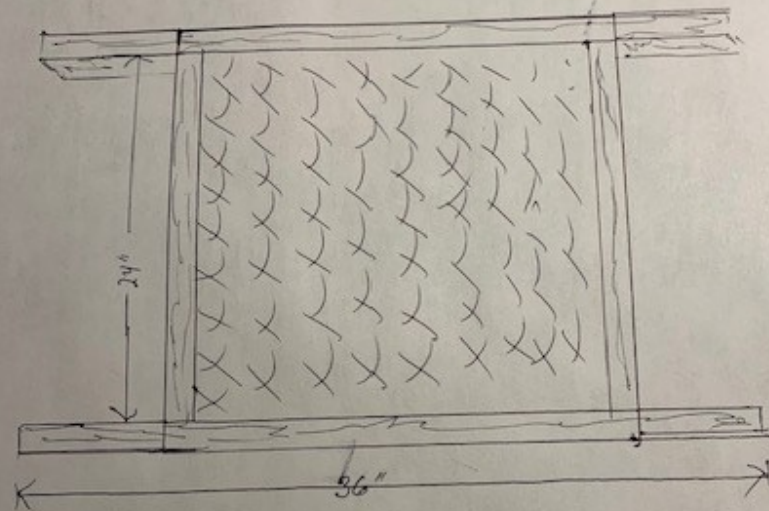
Note: Keep area open under table to place a 5-gal bucket.
